## **Hack Classes:** 10:00 Start

1. Open Schooling Pleasure
2. Senior Pleasure
3. Junior Pleasure
4. Open Walk/Trot Pleasure

*In the **Pleasure class**, the **horses** perform as a group, exhibiting the natural gaits of the walk, trot/jog, and canter/lope. **Horses** are judged on their manners, performance, quality and conformation.*

5. Senior Horsemanship/Equitation
6. Junior Horsemanship/Equitation
7. Open Walk/Trot Horsemanship/Equitation

***Equitation** refers to a rider's position while mounted, and encompasses a rider's ability to ride correctly and with effective aids, **Horsemanship**. In horse show competition, the rider, rather than the horse is evaluated. May be asked to perform an individual test.*

*All hack classes may be ridden English or Western, classes may be split or combined if entries warrant. NO CROSS ENTRY between Jr (17 and under), Sr (18 and over), and walk/trot (all ages). The Open Schooling Pleasure will be W/T/C and open to all.*
