All stalls must be cleaned at end of your show.

A Separate \$40 cheque must be given with your Entries made out to the Vernon Riding Club for stall cleaning after the show.

If you choose to clean your own stall this cheque will be refunded after stall is cleaned before your departure.

CANCELLATIONS, SUBSTITUTIONS, ANF REFUNDS POLICY

• Cancellations made before August 9, 2019 will receive a full refund;

• Cancellations made after August 9, 2019, prior to the start of the show, will forfeit their entries, except where a certificate of disability from a qualified veterinarian or physician is presented to office before start of classes. A fee of \$25.00 will be charged on all cancellation

• Cancellations made after the start of competition will receive a 50% refund of the remaining entries if the office receives an appropriate Doctor's note or Veterinary certificate end of show.

• With a Veterinary certificate a new horse may be substituted for a scratched horse; \$20 fee;

• All entries received after August 9, 2019 are subject to a \$20 late entry fee;

• Changes (add/scratches) of classes are subject to a \$10 flat rate per day.



SHOW INFORMATION

• All entrants must be members in good standing of HCBC;

• Each horse/rider combination must be entered in a separate entry form; all fees must accompany the entry form;

• Appropriate footwear must be worn when mounted;

• Any Junior Rider mounted on a horse must wear ASTM (American Society for testing Materials) or BSI approved helmets, with safety harness correctly fastened, at all the times while on the competition grounds;

• Only Senior Riders may ride or handle stallions anywhere on the competition grounds;

• Competition numbers must be worn and visible at all times in the schooling and exercise areas, as well as in the competition ring, failure to display number may result in elimination or disqualification;

• Only horses wearing a competition number are allowed on the grounds during the competition days;

• Any contestant demonstrating unsafe or unsportsmanlike behaviour in the opinion of the judge will be disqualified for the remainder of the show without refund or entry fees;

• Dogs must be kept on leashes and kept in the trailer parking area; you are encouraged to leave your dog at home;

- Lunging is allowed in the upper sand ring up till one half hour before show commences and after that will be restricted to round pen.
- Take practice fences so the red flag is on your right;

• An adult must be present when a junior rider is jumping in the warm-up ring;

• The management reserves the right to limit entries, or refuse an entry;

• The management reserves the right to cancel, combine, or split classes depending on the number of entries received;

• The management reserves the right to decide any point not covered in the rules and correct any error or omission in the program;

• Protests or objections will be handled by the management.



ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- Senior Riders are 19 years of age or over as of December 31 of the previous year;
- Junior Riders are 18 years and under
- Where 'no cross entries are allowed', this refers to one specific horse/rider combination;
- Ponies are 14.2 HH and under;

RAIL CLASS DESCRIPTIONS

ENGLISH PLEASURE: To be shown at the flat footed walk normal trot and easy canter. Light contact to be maintained. To be judged on manners, performance, quality and conformation. Tack and personal appointments appropriate to seat being ridden. Judged on: (45%) performance, (40%) manners, (15%) conformation. Martingales, breast-pleats and whip/crop not permitted.

ROAD HACK: To be shown at a walk with reasonably loose rein, trot, strong trot, easy canter and hand gallop. Judged on (55%) performance (20%) substance (15%) conformation (10%) manners. Martingales, breastplates and whip/crop not permitted.

HUNT SEAT EQUITATION: Entries judged on rider's ability. Riders will be asked to walk, trot, and canter both directions. Neatness is a first requisite regarding rider's dress. Martingales not permitted, crop/whip allowed, breastplate optional. Riders may be asked to perform an individual test or pattern.

WESTERN PLEASURE: To be shown at the flat footed walk normal jog and easy lope. Light contact to be maintained. To be judged on manners, performance, quality and conformation. Tack and personal appointments appropriate to seat being ridden. Judged on: (45%) performance, (40%) manners, (15%) conformation. Martingales, breast-pleats and whip/crop not permitted.

WESTERN HORSEMANSHIP: Entries judged on rider's ability. Riders will be asked to walk, jog, and lope both directions. Neatness is a first requisite regarding rider's dress. Martingales not permitted. Riders may be asked to perform an individual test or pattern.

COMMAND CLASS: The Command Class is a competition that exhibits the abilities of a welltrained, responsive performance horse. Entries are eliminated, one at a time at the discretion of the judge as commands are not executed correctly. Commands may include stop, jog, lope, reverse, backup, 360 turn on the haunches, 180 turn on the forehand, side pass, counter canter, dismount, mount, flying change, reverse simple change of leads, roll back, walk, etc.

Thoroughbred Incentive Program

High Point Thoroughbred – High Hunter Award: The award will be given to the thoroughbred that accumulates the most points in any 2'6" hunter classes or higher.

High Point Thoroughbred – Low Hunter Award: The award will be given to the thoroughbred that accumulates the most points in any hunter classes under 2'6".

High Point Thoroughbred – High Jumper Award: The award will be given to the thoroughbred that accumulates the most points in any 2'6" (0.85m) jumper classes or higher

High Point Thoroughbred – Low Jumper Award: The award will be given to the thoroughbred that accumulates the most points in any jumper classes lower than 2'6" (.85m)

LEAD LINE/WALK TROT: Lead line classes are open to riders 2 years of age as of December 31 of the previous year, up to and including 6 years old as of December 31 of the previous year. HCBC membership not required but must be controlled by an adult 19 years or older at all times, no cross entries with other classes. Side walkers encouraged. Rider may be asked to trot.

Walk/trot open to beginner riders. Entries not eligible for any other Classes.
