<u>Save the dates of July 3 and 4, 2021</u> for our Gold and Bronze Dressage Show with judges: John MacPherson, Toronto -Sr. EC Dressage Judge and Jayne Essig, Victoria – Med. EC Dressage Judge

Because of the Covid-19 EC and Provincial restrictions we have planned two test riding days July 11 and 12, 2020.

On Saturday, July 11, 2020- EC <u>Level 3 Coach and Grand Prix Competitor Joni Lynn Peters</u> will comment, beside the ring, either after or during the test – at the rider's request. These tests are not judged- Each test will have a 15-minute time slot, allowing riders to repeat or develop a section. It is highly suggested that you prepare to ride without a caller. All levels and tests are accepted-including Freestyles. Simply request your test on the entry form – limit of 3 tests per horse, per day. Western Dressage riders will be grouped together.

Sunday, July 12, 2020- Lynda Ramsay, EC Basic Dressage Judge and Level 3 Coach will work with riders in 15-minute sessions. Commentary will be given at the end of the rides. These tests will be scored but not judged. We are looking forward to 'no pressure' but informative test days.

Jackets are not required. Dress is 'clinic polished'. There are no prizes but some wonderful draw prizes each day, from our **generous ring and show sponsor Sara Vey and Le Tack Truck.** Thank you once again Sara, for your continued support of our sport. It would not be nearly as much fun without you.

Riders are encouraged to read the Horse Council B.C. Covid-19 Resources page. We have included the waiver here, which must be sent with your entries. Group size limits remain at 50 – Maintain a physical distance – the size of a pool noodle – Hygiene requirements will be followed at VDRC. Unfortunately, there will not be a concession.
