



Vernon District Riding Club

The VDRC has many things to offer your Club or Organization. Easily located off Highway 6 at 8408 Aberdeen Road, we have a beautiful and well maintained facility that includes the following amenities.



The VDRC clubhouse, sponsored by **Lavington Pellet**, has a large meeting room, full kitchen, upstairs office, two indoor, and two outdoor washrooms. Outside the clubhouse is a large, covered wrap around porch and a grassy area shaded by trees with picnic tables.



There are three competition rings, each with a judge's booth. **The Rusty Spur Ring** is 110ft by 215ft; it comfortably handles the set up of our dressage ring with room to spare. **The Priscilla/Remax ring** is 200ft by 300ft. During the Hunter/Jumper Show, we divide this ring in half, using one half for warm up and the other half for competition. At other times of the year, a dressage ring is set up on one side. **The Rider's Ring**, our second largest sand ring, is 140ft by 300 ft. During the riding season, jumps are always set up in this ring.

The irrigation system is installed in all three arenas. The jump equipment inventory includes a full hunter course, a full jumper course, additional derby jumps as well as flags, numbers, and an electronic timer. The dressage equipment includes the ring, and several sets of letters. The PA system is broadcast from the upper story of the clubhouse.



Horses may be stabled in the 52 stalls, 8 covered pens, or 16 open pens. The grounds keeper is available for harrowing and maintenance during events, for an extra cost.
