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STABLING

Stalls (Covered Pens): \$25/Day (\$20/Day for VDRC members)

Open Pens: \$15/Day (\$10/Day for VDRC members)

No tack stalls available

All stalls must be cleaned at end of the show.

A **Separate cheque for \$40** must be given with your Entries, made out to the Vernon District Riding Club for stall cleaning after the show. If you choose to clean your own stall this cheque will be returned after stall is cleaned before your departure. Please check in at the office once you are finished cleaning.

OR if you choose, Vernon Pony Club can clean your stall upon departure, and your cheque will be cashed as payment for this service.

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SHOW INFORMATION

- All entrants must be members in good standing of HCBC;
- Each horse/rider combination must be entered in a separate entry form; all fees must accompany the entry form;
- Appropriate footwear must be worn when mounted;
- Any Junior Rider mounted on a horse must wear ASTM (American Society for testing Materials) or BSI approved helmets, with safety harness correctly fastened, at all the times while on the competition grounds;
- Only Senior Riders may ride or handle stallions anywhere on the competition grounds;
- Competition numbers must be worn and visible at all times in the schooling and exercise areas, as well as in the competition ring, failure to display number may result in elimination or disqualification;
- Only horses wearing a competition number are allowed on the grounds during the competition days;
- Any contestant demonstrating unsafe or unsportsmanlike behaviour in the opinion of the judge will be disqualified for the remainder of the show without refund or entry fees;
- Dogs must be kept on leashes and kept in the trailer parking area; you are encouraged to leave your dog at home;
- Lunging is allowed in the upper sand ring up till one half hour before show commences and after that will be restricted to round pen.
- An adult must be present when a junior rider is jumping in the warm-up ring;
- The management reserves the right to limit entries, or refuse an entry;
- The management reserves the right to cancel, combine, or split classes depending on the number of entries received;
- The management reserves the right to decide any point not covered in the rules and correct any error or omission in the program;
- Protests or objections will be handled by the management.

CANCELLATIONS, SUBSTITUTIONS, AND REFUNDS POLICY

- Cancellations made before April 9, 2021 will receive a full refund;
- Cancellations made after April 9, 2021 prior to the start of the show, will forfeit their entries, except where a certificate of disability from a qualified veterinarian or physician is presented to office before start of classes. A fee of \$25.00 will be charged on all cancellations
 - Cancellations made after the start of competition will receive a 50% refund of the remaining entries if the office receives an appropriate Doctor's note or Veterinary certificate at end of show.
- With a Veterinary certificate a new horse may be substituted for a scratched horse; \$20 fee;

- * All Ride times are Pre scheduled and Strictly monitored (3 rounds or 10 min each)
- * Trainers are to book blocks and spaces for all students
 - Jump heights will be adjusted within your time to encourage this
 - Times are booked on first come basis
 - Individual riders welcome to book times
- * Haul in and out encouraged
- * Stabling available, Minimum care takers on grounds outside of booked times.
- * All Trainers, Participants and Family will obey by social distancing rules and regulations, as set by the provincial health authority.
 - Anyone not following these guidelines will be asked to leave the event immediately.
- * Masks are to be worn any time social distancing (6') is not an option
