Hunter Schooling: Height options include poles on the ground, cross poles, 2ft no oxers, 2'3 with fill, and up. Times will depend on entry requests. Please be sure to include your height preference on your entry form.

10 minutes per horse. Multiple horses in the ring means more time in the ring. For example, if 3 horses go in together that is 30 minutes of schooling!

9:00 Jumper Ring

Jumper Clear Rounds: Height options start at 2'3. Prizes for Clear Rounds!

*Start times may be adjusted depending on entries.



SHOW INFORMATION

• All entrants must be members in good standing of HCBC;

• Each horse/rider combination must be entered in a separate entry form; all fees must accompany the entry form;

• Appropriate footwear must be worn when mounted;

• Any Junior Rider mounted on a horse must wear ASTM (American Society for testing Materials) or BSI approved helmets, with safety harness correctly fastened, at all the times while on the competition grounds;

• Only Senior Riders may ride or handle stallions anywhere on the competition grounds;

• Competition numbers must be worn and visible at all times in the schooling and exercise areas, as well as in the competition ring, failure to display number may result in elimination or disqualification;

• Only horses wearing a competition number are allowed on the grounds during the competition days;

• Any contestant demonstrating unsafe or unsportsmanlike behaviour in the opinion of horse show management will be disqualified for the remainder of the show without refund or entry fees;

• Dogs must be kept on leashes.

• Lunging is allowed in the upper sand ring up till one half hour before show commences and after that will be restricted to round pen.

• An adult must be present when a junior rider is jumping in the warm-up ring;

• The management reserves the right to limit entries, or refuse an entry;

• The management reserves the right to cancel, combine, or split classes depending on the number of entries received;

• The management reserves the right to decide any point not covered in the rules and correct any error or omission in the program;

• Protests or objections will be handled by the management.

CANCELLATIONS, SUBSTITUTIONS, AND REFUNDS POLICY

• Cancellations made before April 20, 2022 will receive a full refund;

• Cancellations made after April 20, 2022 prior to the start of the show, will forfeit their entries, except where a certificate of disability from a qualified veterinarian or physician is presented to office before start of classes. A fee of \$25.00 will be charged on all cancellations

• Cancellations made after the start of competition will receive a 50% refund of the remaining entries if the office receives an appropriate Doctor's note or Veterinary certificate at end of show.

• With a Veterinary certificate a new horse may be substituted for a scratched horse;
