



The VDRC, established in 1955, is located at the heart of Coldstream in the Okanagan Valley.

The VDRC Clubhouse has a meeting area with seating, a full kitchen, upstairs office, two indoor, and two outdoor washrooms. Outside the Clubhouse is a covered wrap around porch with seating, and a grassy area with picnic tables shaded by trees.

The VDRC offers 52 stalls, 8 covered pens, 14 open pens, and a wash stall area.

There are three competition sand rings, each with a judge's booth:

The **Swan Lake Ring** is 110ft by 215ft; it comfortably handles the set up of our dressage ring.

The Kalamalka Lake Ring is 140ft by 300 ft. During the riding season, jumps are set up in this ring.

The **Okanagan Lake Ring** is 200ft by 300ft. Regularly, this ring is divided in half, with a dressage ring set up on one side. During the Hunter/Jumper Shows, half is used for competition, and the other half for warmup.

The irrigation system is installed in all three rings, and they're regularly watered and harrowed throughout the riding season.

The jump equipment inventory includes a full hunter course, full jumper course, and additional derby jumps, jump flags, numbers, and an electronic timer. The dressage equipment includes the ring, and several sets of letters. There is a PA system which is broadcast from the second story of the Clubhouse.

The groundskeeper is available for harrowing and maintenance during events for an extra cost.
