#### ABOUT THE PERCENTAGE DAY

- We wish to acknowledge the land on which the VDRC operates is the unceded territory of the Sylix (Okanagan) Peoples.
- The practice day is not a competition. It's a chance to get out in an encouraging "show" atmosphere and have an opportunity to further your dressage skills. Everyone is welcome.
- The objective is to raise your percentages after the judge's feedback. You may opt to re-ride the same test or another test.
- Max. 2 tests per horse/rider combination. For those that wish to ride additional tests, we will accommodate your request if time permits (please contact the secretary)
- Each scheduled test allows for the test riding, plus additional time to for live feedback from the judge.
- Feedback may be videoed/recorded from outside the field of play (outside of the sand area) by a person appointed by the rider. Absolutely no videoing from the inside the test ring/inside the warm-up or within the "field of play areas".
  - NOTE: Tests will have marks but will be left to the rider to tally their score. Instructions are available for those that are not familiar with the process.
- Percentage days are run solely by volunteers. Without their dedication the percentage days would not be possible. Please consider lending a hand. Wish to learn how to scribe or score? Just let us know.
- CLOSING DATES: one week before the percentage day or when all time slots are full. Priority to VDRC members

To avoid disappointment, have your entry in early!
Waiting lists will be in priority of entry received and to VDRC members then non-members.
Entries must be complete on the Compete Easy portal with all accompanying information (See check list).

<u>RIDE TIMES</u>: Posted to facebook VDRC page the evening of Wednesday before the percent day. Times will be emailed to the email on the entry system with Compete Easy.

## **General Information/Rules/Tips:**

WARM UP	No recomming we in the immercaning
ETIQUETTE	No warming up in the jumper ring.  Places do not block the entrepose to the groups are
Eligoeile	Please do not block the entrance to the warm-up.
	<ul> <li>If you need to adjust tack, etc. please do so outside of the warm-up area.</li> <li>Pass left to left.</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Slower moving riders (e.g. walking) please stay to the inside of the ring.</li> </ul>
	Cantering riders and trotting riders to have the track.
	• As a courtesy, please let a rider know when you are passing them and provide as much space as possible.
	• If your equine is prone to kicking, please put a RED ribbon in the tail. Riders please be aware.
	If riding a stallion please put a BLUE ribbon in the tail.
	• Using a headset – please only wear one ear bud so you are aware of what is going on around you.
	Please keep in mind clucking, or voice cues across the warmup ring may be
	disruptive to other equines. Best to stay ringside and cue the rider as they pass
	you.
	Going to serpentine, zig zag or perhaps circle in an unusual spot? Call out your
	intentions to make everyone aware.
	• Not all equines may have seen strollers, umbrellas, or like humans in rain ponchos
	or be fond of dogs ringside. Always approach the warmup area with caution.
	• The warmup ring is intended for those about to enter their class(es) and priority
	will be given to these riders should the warmup ring have more than 6 equines.
PETS	Dogs and other pets are discouraged. If you <u>must</u> bring your pet, it must be well
	behaved and under your direct control on a leash, at all times.
SMOKING	Smoking/vaping is not allowed on VDRC grounds – this includes in any of the
	buildings, including stabling, show office or in competition and warm-up areas.
SCHOOLING	<ul> <li>On Saturday morning volunteers will be preparing the rings.</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Schooling is not permitted within a competition ring unless specifically</li> </ul>
LUNGING	authorized.
	• Lungeing (unmounted) is permitted in designated outdoor lungeing area only.
	<ul> <li>Under no circumstances shall lungeing be permitted in warm-up/show areas.</li> </ul>
NON-	• The non-"competing"/not-participating equine (NCE) is subject to all the rules
"COMPETING"	of the percentage day and VDRC.
<b>EQUINES</b>	<ul> <li>NCE must provide proof of vaccinations, and HCBC coverage and liability</li> </ul>
	coverage (in the event of a riding/commercial stable).

INSURANCE	All owners or competitors are personally responsible for damages to third parties
	caused by themselves, their employees, their agents, trainers, or their equines.
HEADGEAR	All riders must wear properly fitted and fastened safety-approved headgear when
	mounted.
FALLS or if head	Out of an abundance of caution and concern for the rider, should the rider have fallen
hit & concussion	(anywhere on VDRC grounds) in such a way as to have stuck any portion of their head,
suspected	or possibly have sustained whiplash or a concussion the rider will not be permitted to compete and is strongly advised to seek medical attention.
<b>EMERGENCIES</b>	• In the event of an emergency the secretary or percentage day representative will contact 911.
	<ul> <li>Please follow directions of the volunteers (dismount and make way for emergency vehicles).</li> </ul>
	• In the event of an evacuation, please follow the direction of the announcer and volunteers.
CANTEEN	<ul> <li>We will NOT have a canteen. Please pack snacks and drinks or bring change to grab a drink from the VDRC snack and drink fridge located between the washrooms off of the deck area</li> </ul>
	ENTRY INFORMATION
ATTIRE	Rider and equine should be neatly presented.
TURNOUT	Brushing boots and bandages may be worn.
	> Tie downs, martingales are not permitted.
	Bits/general tack rules will mirror those of the governing body – e.g. Equestrian
	Canada, Pony Club, Working Equitation, etc.
RIDE TIMES	If you wish to ride your tests immediately one after another (back-to back)

VACCINATIONS	All equines attending VDRC events must provide proof of <b>Equine Influenza and</b>
	Equine Herpes Virus (1 and 4) vaccinations within six (6) months (+21 days grace
	period) before arrival at VDRC. No equine shall have received vaccination within
	seven (7) days prior to arrival.
HCBC	Proof of Horse Council of British Columbia's membership for 2025 is required to be
membership	submitted with the entry for both equine owner and rider.
Commercial	In cases where the equine is leased (monies exchanged) or used in a riding school or
coverage for	person is being paid to ride the equine, then proof of third-party liability coverage
third party liability	specifically for attending equine clinics and competitions must be provided.
