



About Our 2025 Shows

Hunter Jumper Show June 6-8

The Hunter Jumper Show is one of two provincially rated shows in the BC Interior. It is one of the premier jumping events in the valley and provides an excellent educational and competitive environment.

This EC Bronze show draws up to 100 horse & rider pairs from around Western Canada and the US. There are also several hundred spectators that attend and social events held throughout the weekend.

Interior Desert Circuit Shows

Spring April 26-27 or Summer July 26-27

In partnership with the Kelowna Riding Club the Interior Desert Circuit Shows draws approximately 75-100 horse & riders who collect points throughout the season at 4 shows that culminate in year end awards. This circuit allows people to stay local and makes these shows accessible and affordable to all. This show is also well attended by spectators and has a variety of social events.

Dressage Show May 23-25

The Dressage show is one of only two Gold/Bronze level dressage shows in the interior. Contestants are drawn from all over BC and Alberta and entries are usually between 60-70 horse/riders. Classes range from the very basic walk/trot entry level right up to highly competitive Grand Prix. One of the highlights is the Rising Star division for young riders ages 21 and under. These classes promote the development of young equestrians in a welcoming environment. This event draws many spectators as well.
